HEALTH DEPARTMENT ADDS THREE WALK-IN FLU CLINICS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES

JOLIET – The Will County Health Department has added three walk-in flu shot clinics designed specifically for current and retired state of Illinois employees.

The clinics are scheduled for: September 21, from 8:30-11:30 a.m.; October 1, from 1-4 p.m.; and October 6, from 8:30-11:30 a.m. All three clinics are set for the Health Department's Will County Community Health Center (1106 Neal Avenue) in Joliet.

These newly-added walk-in clinics will immunize participants against seasonal influenza, not the novel H1N1 Swine Flu. Vaccine designed specifically for the novel H1N1 influenza virus is still undergoing clinical trials and is expected to be available in mid-October.

All eligible clinic participants must bring their state identification card, state insurance card, and a Medicare card if applicable. Questions should be telephoned to 815-740-8143, or Emailed to info@willcountyhealth.org.
