HEALTH DEPARTMENT ADDS SOUTHERN WILL COUNTY H1N1 WALK-IN CLINIC

JOLIET - The Will County Health Department will be offering an H1N1 walk-in community clinic January 8, at Wilmington High School (209 Wildcat Court), from 4:30-9:30 p.m.

It will mark the 20th H1N1 walk-in community clinic offered by the Health Department since October 28. Previous clinics have taken place in Joliet, Bolingbrook, Lockport, Frankfort, Plainfield, and Crete.

Persons planning to attend the Wilmington clinic are asked to arrive no earlier than 3:30 p.m. By limiting arrivals to an hour before the clinic begins, officials hope to reduce vehicular traffic and allow for a more orderly school dismissal.

The Illinois Department of Public Health lifted all H1N1 vaccine restrictions December 14. The Wilmington clinic will be open to all ages. Infants younger than six months old and individuals who are allergic to eggs cannot be immunized.
