HEALTH DEPARTMENT SCHEDULES JOLIET H1N1 CLINIC

JOLIET - The Will County Health Department (WCHD) has scheduled a free, walk-in H1N1 community clinic February 7, in Joliet.

The clinic is set for the Spanish Community Center (309 N. Eastern Ave). All are welcome at this event, which is scheduled from 10 a.m.-2 p.m.

WCHD community clinics have distributed more than 25,000 doses of H1N1 vaccine at walk-in events in Joliet, Bolingbrook, Lockport, Frankfort, Romeoville, Plainfield, Wilmington, and Crete. H1N1 vaccine is now also available at the WCHD immunization clinic located in the agency's Community Health Center building (1106 Neal Avenue in Joliet). No appointments are needed for H1N1 vaccine provided at the Community Health Center.

WCHD offices in Bolingbrook (323 Quadrangle), and University Park (44 Town Center) offer H1N1 vaccine by appointment. Southern Will County residents may receive H1N1 vaccine during regularly-scheduled immunization clinics at the First United Methodist Church (401 E. Kahler Road).
