BOARD OF HEALTH ELECTS OFFICERS

JOLIET – The Will County Board of Health re-elected John J. Hines Jr. as president November 17, during its regularly-scheduled monthly business meeting.

A Joliet resident since 1991, Hines has served on the Board of Health since 1998 and now begins his sixth successive term as president. He served as board vice president in 2004, and brings nearly five decades of auditing, finance and accounting experience to his position of leadership and responsibility.
