HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO REVIEW IMMUNIZATION RECORDS: *FREE CHILD RECORD REVIEW HIGHLIGHTS NATIONAL INFANT IMMUNIZATION WEEK*

JOLIET - Is your child up to date on shots?

The Will County Health Department is offering to review shot records for children up to five years old April 25-29, in recognition of National Infant Immunization Week (NIIW). A free magnetic picture frame will be available for each shot record reviewed during the NIIW celebration.

CLINIC HOURS: record reviews and the free magnetic picture frame giveaways will be available Monday and Wednesday from 8:30-11:30 a.m., and 1-4 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday from 8:30-11:30 a.m., and 1-6 p.m. Friday hours are 8:30 a.m. until noon.

NIIW is an annual health observance designed to highlight the importance of protecting infants from vaccine-preventable diseases, while celebrating the achievements of immunization programs. Since 1994, NIIW has served as a call to action for parents, caregivers and healthcare providers to ensure that infants are fully immunized against 14 diseases by age two.
