

Will County: Community/Walk-in Flu Shot Clinics For nearly four decades, the Will County Health Department has partnered with the Senior Services Center of Will County to provide an annual series of walk-in *community* flu shot clinics designed specifically for persons 18 years and older. You must be a Will County resident to attend one of the community clinics.

Additionally, Walk-in clinic hours for children (6 months - 18 years of age) and adults (18 years and older) will start September 1, 2011 at the Will County Community Health Center, 1106 Neal Ave. Joliet, IL. CDC recommends that everyone 6 months of age and older receive a Flu Shot.

Individuals who have had an allergic reaction to a previous flu vaccine, those affected by Guillain-Barrè Syndrome and persons allergic to any component of the flu vaccine should consult a physician regarding the advisability of a flu shot. The annual supply of influenza vaccine and the timing of its distribution cannot be guaranteed in any year. Flu shots are administered according to CDC guidelines, based on vaccine availability. **Refer to the list below for a location near you:**

FEES:

- Adults: \$28.00/vaccination (Medicare/Medicaid accepted - Please bring card)
- Children: \$16.75/vaccination (Children who have insurance that covers their shots are encouraged to obtain their immunizations from their primary care physicians.)
- No one will be denied immunization due to true inability to pay.

Who should get the Flu Shot:

- adults 50 years and older
- persons 19-50 years with underlying chronic medical conditions or immunosuppression
- persons with conditions that compromise respiratory function (i.e. seizure or neuromuscular disorders)
- all women who will be pregnant during the influenza season
- residents of nursing homes and long-term care facilities
- health care workers
- all children ages **6 months through 18 years old** including those on chronic aspirin therapy
- out-of-home caregivers and household contacts of: *children 0-59 months of age; *persons at high risk for complications from influenza
